1. I, Angelina Matsie Motshekga, Minister of Basic Education, after consultation with the Council of Education Ministers and in terms of *Sections 3(4)(l) and 7* of the *National Education Policy Act, 1996 (Act No. 27 of 1996)* and together with *section 6(A)* of the *South African Schools Act, 1996 (Act. No. 84 of 1996)*, hereby give my intention to call for public comment on the National Curriculum and Assessment Policy Statements developed for each subject listed in the *National Curriculum Statement Grades R – 12*, as set out in Schedule 1.

#### BACKGROUND

2. Following my decision to implement recommendations of the Report of a Ministerial Task Team on the implementation of the *National Curriculum Statement Grades R – 12* in schools, I appointed a Ministerial Project Committee with the aim of developing National Curriculum and Assessment Policy Statements for each subject listed in the *National Curriculum Statement Grades R – 12*.
3. A National Curriculum and Assessment Policy Statement is a single, comprehensive, and concise policy document, which will replace the current Subject and Learning Area Statements, Learning Programme Guidelines and

Subject Assessment Guidelines for all the subjects listed in the *National Curriculum Statement Grades R – 12*.
